THIS YEAR'S THEME IS:

"Advancing the Dream: Our Greatness, My Service."

HOW TO ENTER:

- Must be a sophomore, junior, or senior enrolled at UT Arlington or Tarrant County Southeast Campus with a full-time status of 12 semester hours or more.
- Must be able to demonstrate an ongoing commitment to community service by providing a brief statement of volunteer achievements.
- Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA
- Must be able demonstrate financial need (FAFSA score for 2014)
- Essays must be original, typed, double-spaced and not exceed 1,500 words.
- Must include recommendation letters from two faculty members or nonprofit community organizations.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

Friday, December 19, 2014

Interested applicants must also complete and submit an application form, which can be picked up at the UT Arlington Dean of Liberal Arts Office at 210 University Hall or Tarrant County College Southeast Campus Activities Office.
