
"Sharing the Dream" Ecumenical Service Keynote Speaker
The Rev. Dr. Zan Holmes

Noted speaker, published author, preacher, teacher and community activist who has been recognized as an "invisible giant" in the Civil Rights Movement.

For nearly 28 years, Dr. Zan Holmes has served as Pastor Emeritus of St. Luke Community United Methodist Church in Dallas. He is a graduate of Huston-Tillotson University in Austin and has two graduate degrees from the Perkins School of Theology at Southern Methodist University. For nearly 24 years, he has been an adjunct professor at the SMU Perkins School of Theology. Known for his community activism, preaching and teaching, Holmes served in the Texas House of Representatives from 1968 to 1972. He has also served on the University of Texas Board of Regents.
